Z-Park is the oldest and largest science park in China including over 15,000 international and domestic companies in ten industry park complexes. The Beijing Bureau of Commerce plays a key role in developing international business relationships and facilitating reciprocal investments in the U.S. and China. The primary focus of the visiting group is the new bio-medical park formed in 2006, but they represent the other Z-Parks as well.

The Government of China has committed over \$30 Billion (USD) over a ten year period in the development of these park complexes. Companies from the Z-Park range from bio-medical to computer technology, etc., and will be the core participants in the new Nasdaq of China announced in May of this year. Their overall missions are:

- **Entry** of domestic and international businesses and technologies,
- **Organization** for rapid marketing and operational expansion, and
- **Delivery** of advanced technology and business innovation globally.
